

STARS OF STONY BROOK GALA HONORING DOROTHY LICTENSTEIN RAISES \$7.1 MILLION

Nearly 700 guests gathered at Pier Sixty at Chelsea Piers to honor one of America's most dedicated and energetic art and education benefactors, **Dorothy Lichtenstein**, at the 19th Annual **Stars of Stony Brook Gala**.

The philanthropist and wife of the late artist **Roy Lichtenstein** was recognized for her long-running support of a host of arts, cultural and science initiatives at the University, including the Stony Brook Southampton creative writing and film program, one that provides a vital incubator for students and established writers and filmmakers at campuses on Long Island's East End and in Manhattan.

Since its inception in 2000, the Stony Brook Foundation's Stars of Stony Brook Gala had raised \$50 million to support student scholarships and a featured academic program of excellence.
