The Staller Center Outreach Ensemble presents Prokofiev's *Peter and the Wolf*, a playfully narrated concert piece perfect for kids of all ages to experience classical music. *Peter and the Wolf* is described as a "symphonic fairy tale for children" in which the narrator tells a children's story while the orchestra brings the text to life.

Each instrument or instrument family presents a different character within the story. As you listen, try to pick out Peter's theme in the strings, the flute as the bird, the oboe as the duck, the clarinet as the cat, the bassoon as the Grandfather, and the horn section as the big scary wolf!

This unique use of instrument families allows ears of all ages a chance to hear how each instrument plays a very important and different role in the orchestra, while simultaneously coming together to play a much larger sonic story.
